

## PCC AWAY DAY 22 JULY 2017

### What needs working on?

The following details the collated results from the action lists of members on the day, i.e., is the content of what was written on the flip chart sheets which itself derived from the action lists. Recalling, post discussion and personal reflection, each member identified 2 marks to work on, and captured something of what that might look like. The intention was not to set out the detail of any proposed action. The marks in red are those which received multiple comment (the number of times indicated by the multiplier) from different members, hence arguably identify the key areas for the church to prioritise and work on in the year(s) ahead. The multiplier in orange under the healthy church mark indicates the number of times this mark was identified as needing work.

<b>Mark 7: does a few things and does them well</b> <b>x1</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Encourage Sunday duties</li> </ul>

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These results were not dissected/developed in any detail. However, it was noted, that how we view/manage volunteers was critical, how we advertise/welcome people into the small groups is important, the pews was a self contained project, it might be nice to have some more fun, the use of facebook/twitter etc should be considered, the development of a young person band/choir would be great, and potentially offering holiday groups could also be beneficial.
