

## Loving solidarity across difference ... dogged determination to hold on to hope

There will be no Easter services in the Church of Saint John the Evangelist, Palmers Green, North London, this year. That's because the building was badly damaged by fire on New Year's Day and it will take about six months to repair. Sadly, the incident was not an accident – police forensics found that the fire was set deliberately by the high altar and carefully 'nurtured like a barbecue' in order to cause maximum harm.

The arson attack appears to be part of a series of hate crimes against the vicar, the Revd Julie Coleman. She's devastated by the damage as are those who had weddings and baptisms booked. The Revd Julie and her congregation are – in her own words – just about 'hanging on to hope.'

What keeps them going, she says, are the many kindnesses they've received, including from members of other churches and faiths. The local Roman Catholic priest donated beautiful new linen for use on the altar, while Muslim women from Afghanistan hand-made a new chasuble (the garment worn by a priest at Holy Communion) to replace the one damaged in the fire. Julie and her family have been inundated with gifts of groceries and meals.

So while there will be no Easter celebrations in the church itself this year, the essence of Easter most certainly endures in Palmers Green. It's there in the simple acts of human kindness, in the loving solidarity across difference, and in the dogged determination to hold on to hope.

In short, Easter is not cancelled. In fact, the Revd Julie and her congregation will gather for their services in a makeshift worship space in the parish centre this year, deeply conscious of the fire-scarred church building next door, yet still singing 'Alleluia!'. That's what Christians call resurrection – the Eastermorning Jesus emerging from the darkness of the tomb still carrying the wounds of crucifixion and human cruelty – the living embodiment of hardwon Hope, the bright promise of unconquerable Love.
