

Biography

Flávio Albino Rodrigues was born in Viseu, Portugal, in 2000 to a family where his mother and father both played the accordion, so he was drawn to music at a very young age.



He began to read music and play the accordion, alongside guitar, with his father as his professor. Soon he joined his parents in traditional Portuguese folk music groups, playing the guitar, in those groups.

Keen to pursue his studies playing the classical accordion, in 2010 he began studying at the Conservatório Regional de Música de Viseu as an accordion student. He studied there for 8 years, with Professors Abel Moura and Nuno Silva, without ever losing contact with his folk music groups, giving him the opportunity to play to Pope Benedict XVI and Pope Francis in the Vatican, and to perform in front of the Secretary-General of the United Nations, António Guterres, at the United Nations Headquarters in New York.

In 2017 Flávio auditioned for a place at London's Royal Academy of Music and began his accordion studies there in September the following year, with the Head of Accordion. Professor Owen

Murray. Currently in the third year of his Bachelor's degree, Flávio has had masterclasses with such renowned accordionists as Alfred Melichar, Friedrich Lips, Borut Zagoransky, Anita Agnes and Mario Stephano Pietrodarcci.

Some of his main performances have included orchestral participation in two productions with Royal Academy Opera's The Cunning Little Vixen and Lunchbreak Opera's Gianni Schicchi. He also participated in the London International Guitar Competition, playing a duo with the guitarist Diogo Carlos, having been invited by fellow guitarist Steve Goss to represent the Royal Academy of Music.
